WYVERN COMMUNITY ENTERPRISE

Our Community Enterprise provides a range of adult and children's courses during evenings and at weekends. In addition, there are rooms/halls and sports facilities to hire including a full-size AWP (All Weather Pitch), Sports Hall, Gymnasium, Dance Studio, Tennis and Netball Courts, and Athletics Track. The Sports and Fitness Centre provides state-of-the-art fitness equipment and a range of fitness classes.

Our childcare unit contains a nursery and a pre-school on site which caters for children aged 3 months to 4+ years in purpose-built accommodation with experienced staff. We run an after-school club for Fair Oak Infants.
