Leavers Assembly

This will take place on 27th June 2024 and we ask that students are on site by 0825 hrs and go straight to their tutor base. Parents will not be able to enter the venue; however, they are very welcome to watch the students arrive, a spectator area will be set up for you. Unfortunately, there will not be time for parents to take photos at the venue however the Daily Echo will be there to take photos of the students as they arrive. Parking at the venue is limited so you might want to give some thought to your transport arrangements ahead of the event. Prom finishes at 11pm so please arrive promptly to pick up your child.
