

Opening Hours and Fee Information

The Day Nursery is open Monday – Friday 07.45am - 6.00pm, 51 weeks a year, offering full day care or half day sessions. A minimum of two sessions across two days per week is advised to help a child with settling in to the nursery routine and environment.



Breakfast, mid-morning and mid-afternoon snacks, a cooked lunch and a high tea are inclusive with regard to the session time booked. **Please note breakfast is only available up until 8.30am.**

Leopards Room is our term time pre-school which is open 9.00-3.00pm. Children can attend for the full day session or we can offer morning sessions (9am-12pm) or afternoon sessions (12pm-3pm). If your child will be at pre-school during the lunchtime period, please supply them with a packed lunch (a hot meal is available upon request see below for charges). A mid-morning snack will also be offered.

Government funded:

Children are eligible for funded sessions from age 9 months if they meet the eligibility criteria. In our day Nursery (Cubs room, Tigers room and Lions room) we offer stretched funding, this means the funding will be stretched over the 51 weeks we are open, more detailed information about funding is available upon request.

In our pre-school (Leopards room) our term time only room we offer standard funding (38 weeks). More detailed information about funding is available upon request.

Government funding does not cover the cost of food; therefore, food will be charged at £1 per hour during their funded hours.



There is a 10% sibling reduction for families with two or more children attending the same number of nursery sessions (this discount is applied to the older child's fees). Any additional sessions are paid for in full.

There is no charge for bank holidays and over the Christmas period when the nursery is closed. Absences throughout the rest of the year will be chargeable.

Children with a long-term absence may qualify from a fee reduction / retainer under the discretion of the Childcare Operations Manager. Examples of this may be hospital treatment, parental redundancy.

Monthly invoice fees are issued via the FAMLY app in arrears usually by the 5th of the next month, payable by 14 days from the invoice issue date but no later than 20th of the following month, a 10% late fee will apply.

Wyvern College staff will receive a 10% staff discount from their daily fees. (Not for Government funded sessions) plus holiday discount for children below the age of Government funded sessions:

2 x weeks no charge.

3 x weeks 50% reduction.

Registration

If you would like to register your child at Wyvern Childcare, please complete the admission form and return to our Childcare Operations Manager who will then contact you to advise whether a space is available for the sessions you require.

A non-refundable deposit of £50.00 will secure the place and be credited against the first month's fees. Please note the deposit is non-refundable should a space be cancelled if it has been held for longer than 4 weeks.
